Be Aware of Fraud Scams

Scammers target people of all ages, but our elderly community is especially at risk. These criminals can be very convincing, often using fear and intimidation to get what they want. Please remember: you should never feel pressured or frightened into giving away your hard-earned money.

- **Protect your personal information.** Never share Social Security numbers, bank details, or credit card information in response to an unexpected call, text, or email. Legitimate organizations will not ask for this information in that way.
- **Don't be rushed.** Scammers want you to act quickly before you think. A trustworthy business or agency will always give you time to make a decision.
- Watch how they ask you to pay. No legitimate business will demand payment through gift cards, money transfer services, or by depositing a check and sending money back.
- Talk it over first. Before responding, reach out to someone you trust, a friend, family member, or neighbor. Sometimes a second opinion makes the warning signs clear.

If you're ever unsure, stop and call the credit union or a trusted family member before sending money or sharing personal details. Staying alert and cautious can help protect both you and your loved ones from fraud.
